- ✓ **Construction Defects - As an appellate judge from 1983 to 2002, I decided a number of such cases. I have litigated, arbitrated, and mediated disputes involving construction of commercial buildings and pipelines.**

**Other-Employment** - As an appellate judge from 1983 to 2002, I decided a number of such cases. Since 2002, I have litigated disputes in trial and appellate courts over non-competition covenants and other employment issues.

**Other-Energy** – As sole arbitrator, I have arbitrated a multi-million dollar pipeline construction dispute, and as an appellate judge from 1983 to 2002, decided a number of oil and gas cases.

**Hospital Law** – As a litigator and an appellate judge, I decided a number of such cases involving malpractice, hospital privileges, hospital care, and related issues. I was selected as a special master in federal court to serve on a qui tam suit against a hospital.

**Insurance General** – As an appellate judge from 1983 to 2002, I frequently ruled on cases involving all types of insurance issues. As a litigator, I have represented insurance companies (life and worker’s compensation) in matters of coverage, bad-faith, and securities issues, and have sued them for benefits, including business interruption and property damage.

**Other-Technology/IP** – As an appellate judge, I decided a number of cases involving trade secrets and covenants not to compete. As an advocate, I have litigated such issues in trial and appellate courts, representing both plaintiffs (employers – companies) and defendants (companies and individuals).
