The [Draft Protocol](#) is meant to raise awareness about cybersecurity risks and to propose a framework that parties and arbitrators can look to in order to determine reasonable cybersecurity measures for their arbitrations. During a public consultation period that extends through the end of 2018, the Working Group is seeking feedback from the arbitration community about the draft protocol, and this event will be an opportunity to discuss several aspects of the protocol. Participants will have an opportunity to answer several questions relating to cybersecurity via live interactive polling. The event will be followed by a networking reception generously hosted by LALIVE.
