

CPR Selects Johnson & Johnson and General Counsel Michael H. Ullmann for 2018 Corporate Leadership Award



The award presentation will take place at a black-tie dinner on November 13, 2018, at the American Museum of Natural History in NY. This annual dinner draws approximately 500 attendees representing businesses and their general counsel from Fortune 200 corporations, partners from leading law firms, and industry experts and scholars who come together to acknowledge the importance of alternative dispute resolution.
